Recommendations for use

Temperature: between +10°C and +35°C. Surface must be clean and free from dust and grease. Avoid touching exposed adhesive surface of the tape, as this impairs the performance. Pressure sensitive adhesive must be applied with a maximum of pressure in order to achieve maximum pressure level. The indicated level of performance will be reached after a bonding period of 24HRS at +23°C.

Storage and shelf life

Clean and dry in a well ventilated area, preferably at a temperature between +10°C and +30°C. Stored under these conditions shelf life will be a minimum of 12 months.

The above information is given in good faith, but the user should assure himself that the performance of the product is sufficient for his application. The quoted values are average and should not be taken as maximum or minimum values for specific purposes. Option Tape Specialties cannot be held responsible for product failure unless full testing has been carried out. The client has to decide on the tapes suitability for their own applications.
